In 1931 Wally Byam had a dream to build a travel trailer that was light enough to be towed by a car and move like a stream of air. From this dream the Airstream was born, providing first class accommodations for travelers and becoming a symbol of freedom throughout the world.

The Airstream which serves you today is a 1968 Airstream Sovereign International Land Yacht. Originally purchased by a couple in the late 60's, it was towed on the back of an 1968 Cadillac Eldorado to Florida USA, for use during the winter holidays.

Since then it has taken many adventures, from being used as a guest house in New Mexico USA, to becoming a cafe and bar at the world heritage listed Cockatoo Island in Sydney Australia.

In 2018 it made its way down the NSW coastline to the Austinmer Headlands where it currently serves guests of Headlands Austinmer Beach a variety of delicious food and beverages.
